Day 1	Santorini Arrival	
Location:	Santorini, Greece	
Transfer:	Airport (JTR) to Hotel in Imerovigli	
Flight:	Athens to Santorini	
Description:	Welcome to Greece! Upon arrival at the Santorini airport, you will be greeted in the arrivals area by your driver, who will take you to your Santorini select hotel. The remainder of the day is at your leisure. Overnight Santorini select hotel.	
Day 2	Santorini at Leisure	B
Location:	Santorini, Greece	
Description:	Your first full day in Santorini will be sure to leave you with a lifetime of incredible memories and photographs. One of the best ways to take in Santorini is to walk the pedestrian only footpath that clings to the edge of the cliff-tops of the island. The path joins the villages of Fira, Firostefani, Imerovigli and continues over 10 kilometres to the the artist colony of Oia at the edge of the island. Enjoy a dinner in one of the seafront fish tavernas at Ammoudi, one of the finest places to view the world famous sunsets of Santorini. Overnight in Santorini select hotel.

Description:	Though Santorini is a relatively small island, it is full of wonderful surprises and impressive quality. The artist colony and village of Oia is one of the quaintest settlements of the island. Here you will find some of the finest crafts and art in Greece along with fabulous quality restaurants and cliff-top lounges. If you are interested in heading to the beach, Santorini has famous black and red sand beaches that are easily accessible by taxi or local bus. Of course, we strongly encourage you to grab a chair on your balcony and soak in the views and colors of this incredibly unique volcanic holiday paradise. Overnight in Santorini select hotel.

Description:	This evening, a driver will pick you up from the hotel lobby for your private transfer to the port for your ferry crossing to Heraklion, Crete. Upon arrival in the Port of Heraklion, please make your way to Heraklion Airport (a 5 minute taxi ride) to pick up your car rental. Please Note: You must have a valid international drivers licence for your car rental. Upon picking up your vehicle, you can make your way at your leisure to Rethymnon to your select hotel. Overnight Rethymnon select hotel.	
Day 6	Rethymnon at Leisure	B
Location:	Rethymnon, Greece	
Description:	Enjoy your first full day on Crete, Greece's largest island. If you are looking to drive around the island today, ensure you first visit the ancient city of Knossos located less than 20 kilometres from the airport, as it makes a perfect introduction to Crete. Home to the Minoan civilization that flourished more than 4000 years ago, Knossos is one of Greece's most cherished and important archaeological sites. After your visit to Knossos, you might choose to drive a few kilometres to the mountain village of Archanes, famous for being one of Greece's best preserved traditional villages for lunch. Overnight Rethymnon select hotel.	

Day 7	Rethymnon at Leisure	B
Location:	Rethymnon, Greece	
Description:	One suggested option for today's itinerary would be to drive approximately 70 minutes to the medieval port town of Chania. Home to one of the most charming ports in Greece, Chania's old town is pedestrian only and begs to be discovered on foot. An afternoon drive into the hills southwest of Chania will allow you to discover mountain villages rarely visited by today's beach-seeking tourists. Afternoon return to Rethymnon for your overnight.

Description:	Spend today at your leisure or you could opt to take a full day hike down the Samaria Gorge, known as the longest gorge in Europe. Another option would be to drive south and experience the beautiful and rarely visited seaside towns and beaches of southern Crete. Overnight in Rethymnon.

Description:	Enjoy a half day in Rethymnon, then make your way with your rental car back to Heraklion Airport. Drop the vehicle off and board your flight to Rhodes. Upon arrival in Rhodes, your driver will meet you in the arrival hall of the airport and transport you to your hotel. Overnight Rhodes select hotel.	
Day 10	Rhodes at Leisure	B
Location:	Rhodes, Greece	
Description:	Spend today at your leisure exploring the island. Explore the old town of Rhodes, a recognized UNESCO World Heritage Site that dates back to the Middle Ages and is part of the handful still inhabited on earth. Overnight at select Rhodes hotel.	
Day 11	Rhodes at Leisure	B
Location:	Rhodes, Greece	
Description:	What better way to spend the day than combining ancient ruins in the morning and an afternoon of sun on the beach by visiting the acropolis of Lindos, which is perched over a magnificent bay. Overnight Rhodes select hotel.

Description:	After breakfast, your driver will meet you in the hotel lobby for your private transfer to the airport for your short (one hour) flight to Athens. Upon arrival in Athens, a driver will greet you in the arrival hall and take you to your hotel. Overnight Athens select hotel.	
Day 13	Athens Walking Tour	B
Location:	Athens, Greece	
Activity:	Acropolis, City & Acropolis Museum Walking Tour	
	This sightseeing tour will afford you the luxury of experiencing the two most important attractions of Athens. The Acropolis of Athens is one of the most famous archaeological sites in all of Greece. The new Acropolis Museum is the home to the masterpieces of the Acropolis, where they are displayed in stunning surroundings bathed in natural light.	
	The tour begins inside the Syntagma metro station where you will visit the metro Museum with very interesting archaeological artifacts from the daily life of Ancient Athens that came to light during the construction of the metro.	

You will then continue on to the House of the Greek Parliament, the Monument to the Unknown Soldier and watch the changing of the guard. Your tour continues towards the National Gardens and on to the beautiful neoclassical Zappeion Hall, in front of which tower the surviving columns of the Temple of Zeus and Hadrian's Arch, both of which you will have the opportunity to visit. From there you enter the famous Plaka district where you see the statue of Melina Merkouri.

You will enter the Acropolis from the south slope so as to avoid the crowds and also to visit the Dionysus sanctuary and Dionysus Theatre built in the 5th century BC. Your guide will take care of the tickets so you can skip the line. As you begin to ascend the sacred hill a breathtaking view of the city below will unfold.

Your guide will give you a detailed explanation of the glorious monuments of the Acropolis such as the Parthenon, the Erechtheion, the Propylaia, the Nike Temple and the surrounding monuments such as the Odeon of Herodes Atticus, the Ancient Agora, the Observatory as well as the Philopappos, Mars, and Pnyx Hills.

After your tour of the Acropolis site, you will have approximately 45-minutes to descend towards the New Acropolis Museum. You will have ample time to take personal photographs from many vantage points on and around the Acropolis prior to reaching the Acropolis Museum. Its unique design has incorporated the excavations which are visible under stunning glass floors. The Acropolis masterpieces are marked out and given the prominence they deserve through ideal interior atmospheric conditions, natural lighting. Additionally, there is easy visitor access, panoramic views and excellent layout of the exhibition areas. The museum exhibits about 4,000 artifacts.

The tour ends at the Acropolis Museum.

**Description:** Enjoy a full day in Athens. Your day will commence with an Athens Walking Tour, then the afternoon and evening are at your leisure. Overnight Athens select hotel.
